### **Day 1: Arrive Bologna, Italy**

### **Day 3: Bologna - Verona**

**Day 4: Verona**

The rest of the day is at leisure. An operatic performance at Verona's Arena comes highly recommended.

**Day 5: Verona - Lake Como**

Travel to the peaceful town of Mennagio today, with a stop en route in Como, an elegant city steeped in history. A scenic trip on the Como-Brunate cable car offers sweeping views of magical Lake Como, flanked by palatial villas, rose-laden belvederes and rugged slopes.
