Itinerary

Oct 17: Arrive Lisbon, Portugal

Upon arrival in Lisbon, capital of Portugal, you are met by an Abercrombie & Kent representative and transferred to your hotel. This evening, step aboard a historic Lisbon tram and traverse the city on a unique private welcome experience before gathering for dinner in a local restaurant.

Four Seasons Hotel Ritz Lisbon | Meals: D

Oct 18: Lisbon | Private Museum Experience

This morning, discover the Museu Calouste Gulbenkian — one of the world's most important private art collections — during a before-hours private opening. Then, explore Lisbon with a local expert, discovering the charm of this city on the Tagus and entering the Jeronimos Monastery, burial place of the Portuguese royal family. After an afternoon at leisure for further exploration, gather for cocktails at the Palace of the Marquesses de Fronteira, a National Monument of Portugal and one of the finest 17th-century palaces in Europe.

Four Seasons Hotel Ritz Lisbon | Meals: B

Oct 19: Évora | Walled Medieval City

Journey to Évora, a beautifully preserved medieval city, stopping at Jose Maria da Fonseca for a premium wine tasting and lunch en route. On arrival, visit the historic town centre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to view an ancient Roman Temple, the Gothic 13th-century Sé Cathedral with its Romanesque architectural influences, and the striking city walls.

Convento do Espinheiro | Meals: BLD

Oct 20: Mérida & Seville, Spain | Ancient Mérida

Today, drive eastward into Spain, stopping in Mérida to view its Roman amphitheatre, inaugurated in 8 BC to host theatrical performances and gladiatorial combat. Also see an ancient 82-foot-tall aqueduct built from stone and brick. Afterward, continue into Spain's storied Andalusia region for a two-night stay in vibrant Seville. Once there, ride a horse-drawn carriage to a palace where the owners host your private dinner, followed by a performance of flamenco dancing and singing on the patio of this historic home.

Hotel Alfonso XIII | Meals: BD

Oct 21: Seville | Gothic Cathedral & Jewish Quarter

This morning, experience an A&K-exclusive before-hours visit to the Baroque Hospital de la Caridad and hear Gregorian chant performed live. Then, set out on a guided excursion through Seville, including a visit to the largest Gothic cathedral in the world. Proceed to the Jewish Quarter, with its labyrinth of narrow streets dating to the time of Moorish rule. Then, relax during an afternoon at leisure. Later, enter the Royal Alcázar — a monumental palace — for a special after-hours visit. Finish the evening with a dinner of authentic local fare.

Hotel Alfonso XIII | Meals: BD

Oct 22: Granada | The Moorish Architecture of Alhambra

After breakfast, travel to Granada and take in the city. Visit Alhambra, a vast palace and UNESCO World Heritage Site that exemplifies Moorish architecture. Tonight, attend a feast where ancient Moorish cooking techniques are demonstrated alongside a performance of traditional Sephardic music.

Hotel Palacio de Santa Paula | Meals: BLD

Oct 23: Córdoba & Madrid | Jewish Quarter & Mezquita

Travel to Córdoba, where you visit this city's historic Jewish neighbourhood and roam its narrow streets, and then enter the former Great Mosque, now known as the Mezquita, to view its breathtaking Moorish-influenced interior. Enjoy time to explore before boarding a high-speed AVE train to Ride Like a Local to Madrid. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel. Cap off your day of exploring with a fun tapas tour for dinner.

Palacio de los Duques Gran Meliá | Meals: BD

Oct 24: Madrid | Royal Splendour

This morning, enjoy exclusive before-hours access to the Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, one of the world's leading galleries. Then, set out on a city tour that includes the Royal Palace, with its rich decor comprised of marble, stucco and mahogany. Break for lunch at a local restaurant. Enjoy the afternoon and evening at leisure.

Oct 26: Elciego | An Enchanting Food & Wine Experience

Proceed to Elciego and check in to the Hotel Marqués de Riscal. Settle into your luxurious room and admire the hotel's amazing design, created by master architect Frank Gehry. Gaze out upon the vineyard-covered hills surrounding this contemporary retreat from one of its eight terraces and enjoy dinner overlooking the view.

This morning, explore Spain's storied Rioja region, visiting an olive oil mill and sampling their oils, walking through Laguardia, and tasting wine with tapas in one of the village cellars. Oct 28: Bilbao | Guggenheim Museum Tour

After lunch at a local restaurant, fly to Barcelona, settle into your hotel and then enjoy a light dinner.

Oct 29: Barcelona | Gaudí's Unfinished Masterpiece

This morning, set out on a panoramic city tour. See the Barcelona Pavilion, a study in minimalism built for the 1929 International Exposition, and then explore the Sagrada Família, a spectacular basilica designed by Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí. This amazing structure features eight towering spires outside and an incomparably detailed vaulted ceiling inside. Begun in 1882, parts of it are still under construction. Enjoy time for lunch at leisure in the Central Market, also known as La Boqueria, one of the city's many vital marketplaces for fish, meat and produce. Spend your afternoon with time to relax or explore this colourful, vibrant city on your own. Tonight, join your Resident Tour Director and fellow guests for a Scenic Sundowner followed by a festive farewell dinner.

Hotel Marqués de Riscal, Alava



The rural medieval village of Elciego in the Basque Country is home to a rather unusual hotel. Created by Frank Gehry, most famously known for designing the Guggenheim Museum, Hotel Marqués de Riscal is clad with striking ribbon panels of curling silver, gold and pink titanium that glimmer in the sunshine. Hidden beneath the sweeping exterior, you'll find the 148-year old Herederos del Marqués de Riscal winery - the oldest winery in the region - housing a contemporary and luxurious retreat.

Designed to offer a unique experience to visitors, the hotel is a stark contrast to the classic stone architecture of the town. The unique design continues inside with tilted walls, zigzag windows, high ceilings and a collection of bespoke furnishings. Each of the 43 spacious rooms and suites are a work of art and many overlook the Rioja Alavesa grape vineyards. Choose from a Grand Deluxe or Premium Deluxe Rooms, Executive Suite or the spectacular Gehry Suite with a private terrace and panoramic views of Elciego.

Also renowned for its superb gastronomy, the hotel is home to two innovative restaurants. Restaurant Marqués de Riscal is headed by Michelin-starred Spanish chef Francis Paniego and serves dishes local dishes with an haute-cuisine twist. With a selection of fine vintage wines and 200 international labels to choose from, the expert sommelier will be

on hand to perfectly pair your dish. Alternatively, Bistro 1869 serves up regional fare using fresh local produce with views overlooking the mountains and vineyards of the Basque Country. While staying at Marqués de Riscal, a visit to Caudalie Vinotherapie Spa to soak up the benefits of the grape is a must. We love the crushed cabernet scrub followed by a honey and wine moisturising wrap to leave your skin clean, refined and perfectly smooth. Other facilities include an indoor pool, rooftop lounge and elegant wine bar.

Palacio de los Duques Gran Meliá



Located in the privileged Habsburg district next to the Royal Palace, the Opera House and the Cathedral, Leading Hotel of the World Gran Meliá Palacio de los Duques is a luxury urban resort. Inspired by the masterpieces of Velazquez, this beautiful hotel combines two historic buildings - a 13th century convent and the 19th century Palace of the Dukes of Ega and Villahermosa - updated in an avant-garde style with large reproductions of the great master's paintings and a colour scheme inspired by his palette - ochre, indigo and maroon. Behind the magnificent Elizabethan façade are 180 spacious rooms and luxurious suites with different Velázquez portraits in each one. The serene courtyard garden and terrace and rooftop pool offer perfect spots to relax and dining is a treat at a choice of excellent restaurants. A gym and spa complete the leisure facilities.

Hotel Palacio de Santa Paula



Hotel Palacio de Santa Paula is a 75-room property located in the old part of Granada, the result of a careful and meticulous renovation of the old 16th century Santa Paula Convent and cloisters and a neighbouring 14th century townhouse. Original vaulted ceilings and cobbled courtyards remain, as well as a Moorish patio, alcoved staircase and even the tombs of a few of the convent's former inhabitants. 'El Claustro' restaurant, housed in the old convent library, is one of the city's best.

Hotel Alfonso XIII, Seville



The Hotel Alfonso XIII was created in unique Andalusian style for the Exhibition of the Americas in 1928 and was opened by King Alfonso XIII. Since then it has been the home in Seville of Royalty, Heads of Government, film stars and every other important visitor to the city. The iconic Alfonso XIII is an unique landmark which embodies the hospitality, aesthetic genius and traditional harmony of life that characterises Seville.

It is located in the historic centre near the banks of the Guadalquivir and only a few minutes from the Royal Palace of the Alcázar, the Cathedral, the Plaza de España and the delicious flower filled Barrio Santa Cruz. The Hotel Alfonso XIII features 151 rooms all tastefully decorated in Moorish, Castilian and Classic styles all sparkingly renovated in the multimillion dollar refurbishment completed in 2012. The San Fernando restaurant offers traditional Spanish and European cuisine, the Bodega Alfonso, which has a charming terrace overlooking the gardens, offers tapas; and the newly created Taifas, set under the trees, a fusion of Andalusian and contemporary cuisine.

The 282 rooms feature fresh and elegant décor, enhanced by 18th-century replica furnishings and contemporary Portuguese art. Most come with a private balcony, so you can sip wine in the sunshine whilst spotting the city’s historic sites.

Enjoy the panoramic view of Lisbon from the penthouse fitness centre, or gaze out over the park as you dine on the fine cuisine of the acclaimed Varanda Restaurant. The old town is a short stroll down cobbled streets, making Four Seasons Hotel The Ritz Lisbon an ideal base from which to explore this charming capital.
