After breakfast transfer by limousine to the Russell ferry, continuing by water to Paihia.

Your escape comes to an end today, as you meet your A&K driver in the lobby and transfer by private vehicle to the Bay of Islands Airport for your onward flight.

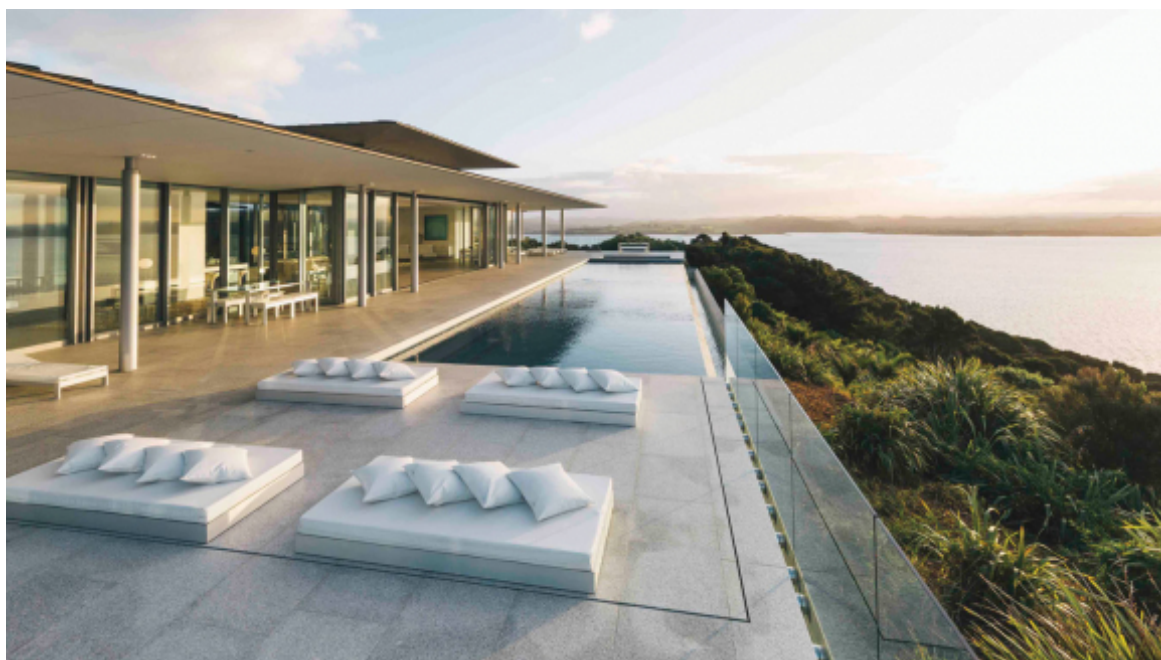
